You can help!

- <u>Hear</u> your child read regularly and sign their record book to confirm the book has been read at home. Pupils should have a minimum of **two child signatures** and **one adult signature** for the week. Stickers and a weekly prize draw are rewards given for reading records being signed! If the reading record is not signed for the week your child will read at playtime to catch-up.
- <u>Help</u> with homework tasks, where your child can choose which piece of homework to finish and when (see Homework Sheet). You can also conduct research around learning at school to share with the class-room.
- <u>Encourage</u> your child to learn their weekly spellings and practise their times tables using the Times Tables Rock Stars app.
- **Support** your child to locate and find information about their topic work.
- <u>Check</u> that your child has a full P.E. kit in school at all times (Shorts, white T-shirt and black pumps have to be worn for all sessions).

Termly objectives will include:

- To learn about why natural disasters occur and how they impact on peoples' lives around the world. Our key question is: "Is Our World Falling Apart?"
- To learn how to locate human and physical features on a range of maps and a globe.
- To learn how to produce a digital magazine.
- To learn about how different faiths in our community worship.
- To learn about our circulatory system and answer key scientific questions What it looks like and what it does; to learn about the heart What is it and what does it do?; to learn about the blood What is it and why is it needed?; to learn about water in our bodies Why do we need water and what happens to water in our bodies?

- Reading packet including their reading record, reading book and spelling word book.
