The children will learn a variety of nursery rhymes.

Seasons: The children will use their senses to explore the changing seasons and begin to develop an understanding of changes over time.

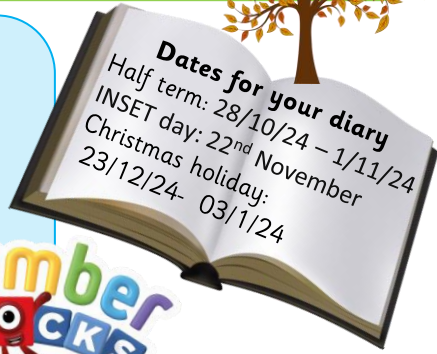


Reception

Stories: Jake's First Day, Marvellous Me!, The Tiger Who Came to Tea, Handa's Hen, Ruby's Worry, Room on a Broom, Charlie the Firefighter.

RML: Our phonics scheme teaches children to hear, say and write sounds in words. The children will quickly feel confident and successful. as they will be taught in groups daily. More information to follow.

Maths: The children will build on previous experiences and further develop their subitising and counting skills. They will be exploring the composition of numbers within 5 and compare sets of objects using the language of comparison.



Makaton is a unique language programme that uses symbols, signs and speech to enable people to communicate. We will be teaching Makaton as part of our Early Years curriculum.
